Bingo for Children and Families

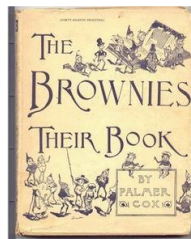
May 31, June 14 & 28, July 12 & 26 and August 9

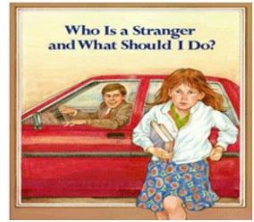
